

FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY Special Academic Program in Finance

Study two semesters at Florida State University (FSU), Florida, U.S.A, while completing your bachelor's degree from your home university. FSU's *Special Academic Program* integrates students academically, socially, and culturally into university life at an outstanding research institution. The program is designed for 4th year students who want to increase their job prospects by perfecting their English or those who plan to go to Graduate School in the U.S. Successful program participants may apply for a three-semester Master in Finance.

Program Dates: August 2016-May 2017 Nomination Deadline: January 4, 2016 Program Fee: \$29,500 (including housing and food)

The Program Fee covers FSU tuition and fees, housing and meals, a regular schedule of cultural and social events, and ongoing staff support, including FSU students who serve as peer mentors. International students coming to FSU on their own for two semesters and taking similar classes would typically pay \$21,500-\$24,500 for tuition and fees alone. Housing and food for two semesters would be a minimum of \$10,000 in additional expenses.

Student benefits:

- Study in upper-level classes with American students
- Live in a residence hall with other program participants and American students
- Work closely with FSU's high-caliber faculty
- Participate in the academic and social life of the hosting FSU department, allowing easy transition from

under-graduate to graduate studies

Student Eligibility

Apply during your 3rd year to ensure a place at Florida State University for your 4th year. Strong applicants will have an 80 on the ibTOEFL or a 6.5 on the IELTS, have a grade point average of 3.0 or equivalent, and be enrolled in the 3rd or 4th year of a qualifying major at the partner university.

Students should plan to sign up for and take the English proficiency exam in the fall prior to applying for the *Special Academic Program* in order to submit exam scores with their applications.
